



HIGH COST CLAIMANT REPORT

What is captured in this report?

The High Cost Claimant Report displays the total amount of medical claims paid that exceed a specified dollar amount in descending order by paid amount. The report also presents the member's relationship to the employee (employee or a dependent). This report does not include prescription drug claims and does not track toward the specific stop loss deductible of your reinsurance contract.

Why run this report?

Typically, users create this report to view the number of members who are close to reaching the Specific Deductible amount. This is useful for determining the potential for claims covered by specific stop loss insurance.

What are the required data parameters?

Users must specify a range of incurred and paid dates. Additionally, they must enter the dollar amount that the reported claims must exceed. The amount entered must be \$5,000 or greater.

What time periods are available?

The data is refreshed nightly and is available as far back as 36 months from the current month.
